HUSH—KEITH'S BACK HOME FROM AUSTRALIA

HUSH's Norwich-based singer is with a band whose first three albums went gold and who are one of the top ten bands in the country.

The singer is Keith Lamb, the band is Hush, and the country is Australia.

Keith is back in Norwich at the moment — taking time out from a successful career of Australia that ran up several hits of £50,000 a year — and we're glad to have the opportunity to swallow our periodic insights into the real "livelier makes good" story.

Another Norwich man, Bobbi Jackson, was in the original line-up, but the new line-up lineup have established themselves as the renegade of the Australian music scene, with regular features on their appearing in all kinds of publications and the record — a version of "Rock Therapy" — staying in the charts for 28 weeks.

Having made it as big as possible in Australia, the band are setting their sights on Europe — and particularly Keith's native U.K.

A concert has been provisionally arranged for the Royal Albert Hall next March and there are hopes of getting records released here by N.C.A. We'll keep you informed about developments.
